PLAYFUL SHADES | PAPER FLOWER PATTERN

- INSTRUCTIONS:
1. Choose 3 different patterned papers that coordinate nicely.
 2. Using the pattern below, cut a cardboard template in each of the 3 sizes. Use the cardboard template to trace 5 petals from each of the 3 patterned papers that you have chosen.
 3. Using scallop scissors (available from craft or art supply stores), cut out the traced petals.
 4. Fold each petal in half vertically along the centre to give the appearance of a spine.
 5. Punch a small hole through each petal as indicated on the pattern.
 6. Position the petals in a pile, aligning the holes perfectly, with largest on the bottom, mid-size in the middle and smallest on top.
 7. Thread a small brass fastener through the hole, top to bottom. Turn over to reveal the underside of the petal pile. Split the fastener to keep them grouped together.
 8. Fan out the petals to resemble a flower.
 9. Use ribbon to make a little ball and adhere to the centre of the flower to cover the brass fastener.
