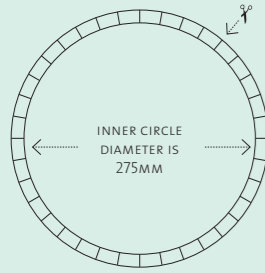

STYLE GUIDE

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Have circular raiser boxes cut to size - ours are based on a diameter of 275mm.
2. In light pencil, trace the shape of the raiser box on the reverse side of this printed sheet. Draw another circle 10mm wider around the tracing of the raiser box. Cut the wider circle to shape and then cut snibs every 10mm into the inner circle being careful not to cut further than the traced line.



3. Position the raiser box in the centre of the circle, coloured side facing out, and fold the tabs down the side, securing each one with a small piece of tape.
4. Cut the side band to the height of the raiser box required – we used 25mm, 40mm, 50mm and 60mm raiser boxes – and wrap around the side of the box securing with small dress-maker pins positioned in inconspicuous spots. You will need to use multiple bands to make up the width of the raiser box – overlap them slightly and, if appropriate, ensure the pattern matches up between the bands.
